FAMU College of Law Holds Accreditation Celebration

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. – Nearly 200 guests assembled to celebrate the accreditation of the Florida A&M University (FAMU) College of Law during a program held in the school's atrium on Saturday, October 3, 2009. The FAMU College of Law received full accreditation from the American Bar Association on July 29, 2009. The program featured remarks by FAMU Trustee Daryl Parks, FAMU President James H. Ammons, law school Dean LeRoy Pernell and Student Bar Association President James Simmons. The event also featured recognition of several individuals lauded for their efforts to reestablish the law school in Orlando including: former FAMU President Frederick S.
