**SCHEDULE FOOTNOTES**

1 – Required course must be taken this semester.

2 - Students may not take this course if they have completed Advanced Topics in Law: Defamation and Privacy.

3 – **Only** seminars and independent research projects satisfy the Upper-Level Writing Requirement.

4 – Students may not withdraw from clinics after the end of the add/drop period.

5 – Enrollment **ONLY** with Professor Abate's permission.

6 – Registration by application and permission **ONLY**. To register, students must complete two steps. First, the student must submit an approved outline and application, signed by the professor who will supervise and evaluate the research paper. Second, students must submit the signed application to Associate Dean Jones for final approval. The supervising faculty member must be a member of the full-time faculty who does not teach in the Legal Methods Program or in the Academic Success Program. Obtain the application from the Registrar's Office or from the College of Law website. The completed application **MUST** be submitted to Associate Dean Jones no later than the **FIRST DAY OF CLASSES**.
