**SCHEDULE FOOTNOTES – Read these notes for important information regarding the Fall 2015 schedule.**

- 1 – Fall classes end on Tuesday, November 17. The College of Law will operate a *WEDNESDAY* class schedule on Tuesday, November 17 to make up the Veteran's Day Holiday. The make-up day for Labor Day will be Monday, November 16.
- 2 – Students must take Business Organizations no later than the term in which they expect to graduate. Business Organizations will be offered in both day and evening sections in
- 3 – Third-year part-time students must take Evidence in Fall 2015.
- 4 – Completion of the following courses is highly recommended before enrolling in Florida Bar Law & Skills: "Wills and Estates, Family Law, and Florida Constitutional Law.
- 5 – Evidence is the prerequisite for Trial Practice
- 6 – ONLY Seminars and Independent Research Projects satisfy the Upper-Level Writing Requirement.
- 7 – Students may not withdraw from clinics after the end of the Add/Drop period..
- 8 – Students enrolling in a clinic must attend a mandatory orientation on **TBA** at 8:00 am & 5:00 pm in the Clinic Conference Room (Rm. 184). Meeting days and times for clinics other than Homelessness & Legal Advocacy will be determined at the orientation meeting.
