## BACKGROUND

*Benjamin L. Lampkins born May 25, 1937, was a graduate of Florida A&M University's undergraduate Political Science program and Florida A&M University Law School. It was obvious wherever his many travels took him that he loved and held great pride for Florida A&M University. He made great strides in the field of law in Broward County and was the first African-American Assistant Public Defender in the State of Florida. He enjoyed representing the underprivileged and those who could not afford to hire an attorney. He also worked diligently in the FAMU Broward Alumni Chapter until his death, November 2, 2006. To maintain his legacy, the Broward County Alumni Association created the Benjamin L. Lampkin School of Law Scholarship.*



## GUIDELINES

1. The purpose of this Scholarship is to provide financial support to students attending Florida A & M University School of Law.
2. Applicant must be:
  - A graduate of Florida A&M University
  - A first year or current full time Law School student who has performed well based upon the minimum requirements of the University or the School of Law with a 2.5 GPA or higher.  
*(The personal and financial circumstances of applicants will also be considered)*
3. A Broward County resident. If there is no applicant from Broward County, the scholarship may be available to a student from the State of Florida at the discretion of the Broward County Alumni Chapter.
4. Applicant should submit an application form, official sealed transcript, two letters of reference of which one must be from a Professor or Law School Dean, and a one page summary outlining their personal and financial circumstances.
5. The total value of the award is \$1500.00. The scholarship will be awarded in two equal sums in August and January. The scholarship will only be disbursed to the student according to FAMU policies and procedure, and that absolutely under no circumstances will checks be made payable directly to a student, parent or guardian. Payments of installments are subject to the scholarship recipient's continued enrollment and satisfactory progress in the program.
6. If any candidate declines the scholarship, the Broward County Alumni Chapter reserves the right to allocate the scholarship to another candidate. The scholarship must be accepted in the year for which it is offered.
7. Any incomplete application will not be considered.  
Application Deadline : MARCH 31 of each year the scholarship is offered.
