SCHEDULE FOOTNOTES

1 – These three courses are workshop-based skills seminars. They do not satisfy the upper-level writing requirement. ONLY Advanced Legal Research and Independent Research Projects satisfy the Upper-Level Writing Requirement in Summer 2017.

2,3 – Students may not withdraw from clinics after the end of the Add/Drop period.

4,5,6 – Enrollment ONLY with Professor Abate's permission.

7 – Registration by application and permission ONLY. To register, students must complete two steps. First, the student must submit an approved outline and application signed by the Professor who will supervise and evaluate the research paper. Second, students must submit the signed applications to the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs for final approval. The supervising faculty member must be a member of the full-time faculty who does not teach in the Legal Research and Writing Program or in the Academic Success and Bar Preparation Program. Obtain the application from the Registrar's Office or from the College of Law website. The completed application MUST be submitted to the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs no later than the FIRST DAY OF CLASSES. **LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE APPROVED.**
