## Reciprocal Health Care at Student Health Services in the Florida University System

There has been an agreement among the Florida State University System (SUS) Student Health Services' to participate in a mutual exchange of care for enrolled students while assigned at locations other than their home campus. For example, under this agreement a FAMU student located in Orlando may utilize health care services at the University of Central Florida. To enable this agreement the following must occur:

- Each semester the FAMU academic program will send a list of enrolled students and their
  assigned location to FAMU Student Health Services. The clinic Director will then notify the SUS
  institution closest to the student placement, of FAMU students studying/working in their area
  with a request to allow them access to clinic services.
- 2. The FAMU student is then able to access clinic services at the distant university. The student must present current student identification and pay the health fee of the institution where they are seeking services. The student is financially responsible for any charges generated during their visit. Some clinics will bill insurance, so if the student has health insurance coverage, they are advised to present their insurance card at the time of service.
- 3. The student will notify FAMU Student Health Services that they accessed services at the other institution. With appropriate documentation, FAMU Student Health will submit a refund request for the student. The Office of Student Accounts is responsible for processing refunds. Note: If there is an outstanding balance on the student's account, the refund will be applied to reduce the outstanding charges.
- 4. Services will vary across institutions. Health fees, hours of operation and availability of ancillary services will differ among the facilities.
