Background and Purpose

The Hispanic Bar Association of Central Florida (HBACF) is proud to announce its scholarship application for the 2022-2023 academic year with the goal of better serving the Hispanic community in Central Florida though legal education. The HBACF scholarship is made possible through the generous donations of HBACF members, Themis, The Umansky Law Firm, friends and HBACF fundraising efforts. For the 2022-2023 academic year, a scholarship will be awarded to a deserving student of Hispanic descent, from either Barry University School of Law or FAMU College of Law, who has demonstrated leadership and involvement on campus and in the general community.

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants for the HBACF Scholarship must meet the following criteria:

- Must be a student currently attending Barry University School of Law or FAMU College of Law and is currently considered a 3L or higher as defined by the school of attendance;
- Although there is no cumulative GPA minimum requirement, academic achievement and excellence will be strongly considered;
- Must be of Hispanic descent or heritage; and
- Must have campus and community involvement and/or leadership.

Award and Selection Process

The HBACF Scholarship consists of a Themis Bar Prep Package and two book awards valued at \$500 each. The award will be distributed by HBACF in conjunction with the Themis Bar Prep, and The Umansky Law Firm for the 2022-2023 school year.



The HBACF Scholarship award recipient will be required to attend 2022 Holiday Domino Tournament where the recipient will be publicly announced.

The HBACF Scholarship award recipient will also be invited to attend the HBACF Installation event and must join HBACF for a term of 1 year (the membership fee will be waived).

The HBACF Scholarship award recipient will be selected by a committee composed of HBACF board members, which will evaluate applicants on the following criteria:

- Academic achievement;
- Personal essay;
- Community service, leadership or volunteerism;
- Letters of recommendation;
- Financial need (Not a determinative factor);
- Military Service (Not a determinative factor); and
- Video Submission

Application Deadlines

Complete applications must be *sent via email* to **hbacf.foundation@gmail.com** by 5:00pm EST on Monday November 14, 2022. The HBACF Scholarship award recipient for the 2022-2023 academic year will be notified of his or her selection on or before Friday November 18, 2022.

- Family background;
- Hispanic heritage;
- Leadership and Community roles and activities;
- Volunteerism;
- Honors, achievements, and awards;
- Career goals or aspirations;
- How you plan to give back to the Hispanic community after graduating law school; and
- Financial need
- Military Service (if applicable).

Transcript and Resume:

The following <u>MUST</u> be submitted with this application:

- An official or unofficial law school transcript from your current and any past law school(s) attended. (The HBACF reserves the right to request official transcripts prior to awarding any scholarship.)
- A resume detailing your educational and work history, as well as any special skills, licenses, credentials, experiences and achievements.

Letter(s) of Recommendation or Video Submission:

• The applicant has a choice of submission letter(s) of recommendation or a video submission describing your eligibility for the scholarship. Both options will be weighed equally and are subject to your personal choice.

Letter(s) of Recommendation:

• One or two letters of recommendation, addressed to the HBACF Scholarship Committee, must be submitted with this application. The letters can be emailed to hbacf.foundation@gmail.com. Such letters should be regarding your academic, community service, personal achievements, and potential for future success. In addition, such letters may address the maturity, motivation, self-confidence, leadership, and commitment of the applicant ; or

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Video Submission

- In lieu of a letter of recommendation, applicants may submit a personalized video submission. The applicant has creative control over the video submission and what to include therein. The video must not be longer than 3 minutes. The video must be emailed along with application in a zip folder containing all scholarship requirements to **hbacf.foundation@gmail.com.**
- If you intend to have a video submission, email **hbacf.foundation@gmail.com** prior to **4:00pm EST** on Monday November 14, 2022 to receive a link to upload your video submission. Your video submission must be uploaded within 24 hours of receiving the upload link. Please name your file firstname.lastname so we can identify who the video belongs to.
