## **PROGRAM OVERVIEW**

AT&T Legal Scholars is a collaboration between AT&T's Legal Department, Kilpatrick, and Krevolin & Horst as part of these entities' efforts to promote inclusion within the legal profession. AT&T Legal Scholars is a two-day intensive workshop designed to provide participants with insight into the legal profession and the tools necessary to succeed in law school. Among other things, selected scholars will experience simulated law school classes and will receive feedback on graded homework assignments; will receive instruction on legal writing; will be guided on case-briefing, outlining and time management; and will hear from law school deans and current law students on how to successfully transition from the last year of college to the first year of law school. Scholars will also have the opportunity to network with and develop personally and professionally from inhouse counsel in a Fortune 100 corporation and other prominent members of the legal community. The 2025 AT&T Legal Scholars program will take place virtually July 17-18.

Space is limited. Thus, interested students are encouraged to apply early.
