

STUDENT DEGREE AUDIT CHECKLIST INFORMATION

Students should use the degree audit checklist to plan and track their progress toward meeting the requirements for earning the Juris Doctor (J.D.) degree. Students should review their unofficial transcript each semester in preparation for registration and compare it to the degree audit checklist requirements. Review the transcript to confirm the number of credit hours earned toward the total of 90 required for graduation and to map overall progress toward meeting all graduation requirements listed below. For details regarding the J.D. degree requirements, see the Student Handbook.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENTS TO TRACK

Check your progress toward graduation using your transcript and the degree audit checklist. To be eligible for the award of the J.D. degree, students must meet each requirement below <u>and</u> must be approved by the College of Law faculty.

- All required courses successfully completed.
- Upper-level writing Requirement satisfied (credits earned in a seminar, approved advanced drafting course, approved two (2) credit independent research paper, or law review note written by a FAMU Law Review member accepted for publication in a co-curricular law school journal as certified by the FAMU Law Review faculty advisor).
- Experiential Learning Requirement satisfied (six (6) credits required; credits earned in legal clinics, the field placement program, or designated simulation courses may be used to satisfy the Experiential Learning Requirement)
- Total of at least 90 credit hours earned.
- No more than 30 semester credit hours earned at any other law school.
- At least 64 credit hours earned in courses that require attendance in regularly scheduled classroom sessions or direct faculty instruction.
- Cumulative and semester grade point average of 2.00 or higher.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENT FOR GRADUATION (NOT TRACKED IN STUDENT DEGREE AUDIT CHECKLIST)

A student must be approved by the College of Law faculty to be eligible for the award of the J.D. degree.
