Requirements for the J.D. degree:

- Students must satisfy the Experiential Learning Requirement by completing a total of 6 credit hours from one or a combination of the following options: Simulation (*professional skills*) courses, Field Placement(s), or a Law Clinic.
- To satisfy the “Upper-Level Writing Requirement,” students may either complete an Independent research project paper for 2 credits or a paper in a seminar course (review the current Student Handbook for more details).
- Earn a cumulative grade point average of 2.00 or better for all law school courses taken.
- Be approved by COL Faculty.
