5 – Enrollment **ONLY** with Professor Abate's permission.

6 – Registration by application and permission **ONLY**. To register, students must complete two steps. First, the student must submit an approved outline and application, signed by the professor who will supervise and evaluate the research paper. Second, students must submit the signed application to Associate Dean Bullock for final approval. The supervising faculty member must be a member of the full-time faculty who does not teach in the Legal Methods Program or in the Academic Success Program. Obtain the application from the Registrar's Office or from the College of Law website. The completed application **MUST** be submitted to Associate Dean Bullock no later than the **FIRST DAY OF CLASSES**.

LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE APPROVED.
