<p>1 – Students must take Business Organizations no later than the term in which they expect to graduate. Business Organizations will be offered every semester.</p> <p>2 – Second year full-time students must take Criminal Law in either the Fall Semester or Spring Semester of the 2017-2018 academic year.</p> <p>3 – Completion of the following courses is highly recommended before enrolling in Florida Bar Law & Skills: Wills and Estates, Family Law, and Florida Constitutional Law.</p> <p>4 – Evidence is the only prerequisite for Trial Practice.</p> <p>5 – ONLY Seminars and Independent Research Projects satisfy the Upper-Level Writing Requirement.</p> <p>6 – Students may not withdraw from clinics after the end of the Add/Drop period.</p> <p>7 – Students enrolling in a clinic must attend a mandatory orientation on TBA at 8:00 am & 5:00 pm in the Clinic Conference Room (Rm. 184).</p> <p>8 - Registration by application and permission ONLY. To register, students must complete two steps. First, the student must submit an approved outline and application signed by the Professor who will supervise and evaluate the research paper. Second, students must submit the signed applications to the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs for final approval. The supervising faculty member must be a member of the full-time faculty who does not teach in the Legal Methods Program or in the Academic Success and Bar Preparation Program. Please see the College of Law website for a list of faculty members. Obtain the application from the Registrar's Office or from the College of Law website. The completed application MUST be submitted to the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs no later than the close of business on January 8, 2018.
