SCHEDULE FOOTNOTES – Read these notes for important information regarding the Fall 2018 schedule.

- 1 – Fall classes end on November 26, 2018. November 27 & 28, 2018 are designated inclement weather days to be used as needed. The make-up day for Labor Day is November 21, 2018 (the COL will operate a Monday schedule). The make-up day for Veterans Day is November 26, 2018 (the COL will operate a Monday schedule).
- 2 – Students **must** take Business Organizations no later than the term in which they expect to graduate. Business Organizations will be offered in both day and evening sections in Spring
- 3 – Second year full-time students must take Constitutional Law II, Evidence and Professional Responsibility in Fall 2018.
- 4 – Second year full-time students must take Criminal Law in either the Fall Semester or Spring Semester of the 2018 - 2019 academic year.
- 5 – Completion of the following courses is highly recommended before enrolling in Florida Bar Law & Skills: Wills and Estates, Family Law, and Florida Constitutional Law.
- 6 – Evidence is the prerequisite for Trial Practice.
- 7 – ONLY Seminars and Independent Research Projects satisfy the Upper-Level Writing Requirement.
- 8 – Students may not withdraw from clinics after the end of the Add/Drop period.
- 9 – Students enrolling in a clinic must attend a mandatory orientation on **August 15, 2018** at 8:00 am & 5:00 pm in the Clinic Conference Room (Rm. 184).
- 10 - Obtain the Field Placement application from the College of Law website. The completed application must be submitted to Associate Dean Boothe-Perry no later than the close of business on August 20, 2018. **LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE APPROVED**.
- 11 - Registration by application and permission ONLY. To register, students must complete two steps. First, the student must submit an approved outline and application signed by the Professor who will supervise and evaluate the research paper. Second, students must submit the signed applications to the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs for final approval. The supervising faculty member must be a member of the full-time faculty. Please see the College of Law website for a list of faculty members. Obtain the application from the Registrar's Office or from the College of Law website. The completed application MUST be submitted to the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs no later than the close of business on August 20, 2018. **LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE APPROVED**.
- 13– Highly recommended academic skills course for all upper-level students. This class meets weekly beginning Monday, August 20, 2018.
