- 11 – Registration by application and permission ONLY. To register, students must complete two steps. First, the student must submit an approved outline and application signed by the Professor who will supervise and evaluate the research paper. Second, students must submit the signed applications to Associate Dean for Academic Affairs for final approval. Obtain the application from the Registrar's Office or from the College of Law website. The completed application MUST be submitted to Associate Dean for Academic Affairs no later than the last day of the drop/add period. **LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE APPROVED.**
