A Rattler for Justice is...

Someone who strives to shake up the status quo to encourage positive growth; someone who seeks to rattle a few cages to ensure justice is served; or someone who serves as a catalyst for change while assisting others in need. If you fit the description of a *Rattler for Justice*, you're encouraged to apply for the FAMU College of Law *Rattler for Justice Scholarship*.

The *Rattler for Justice Scholarship* will recognize students who are using their talents and skills to change the world around them, whether that's on the FAMU College of Law campus, in the Central Florida community, or in legal education in general. The scholarship will provide full in-state tuition for the Fall 2020 and Spring 2021 semesters. Up to three (3) *Rattler for Justice Scholarships* will be awarded for the 2020-2021 academic year.

Eligibility

- Currently enrolled in the full-time day program with no more than 30 credit hours as of Spring 2019 or part-time evening program with no more than 30 credit hours as of Summer 2019;
- Expected to graduate no later than Summer 2021 semester;
- Cumulative Grade Point Average of 2.5 at the end of the Spring 2019 semester for full-time day program or Summer 2019 semester for part-time evening program;
- Public or community service experience while in law school.



Submission

- Applicants will submit an essay addressing the following question: ***How have you demonstrated that you are a Rattler for Justice and how will that experience help to advance your legal career?***
- The essay must be 800 to 1,000 words; Applications must be submitted via: <https://conta.cc/2mHyL28>

- Recipient must be present at Rattler for Justice Scholarship Reception on **November 22, 2019** to receive award.
